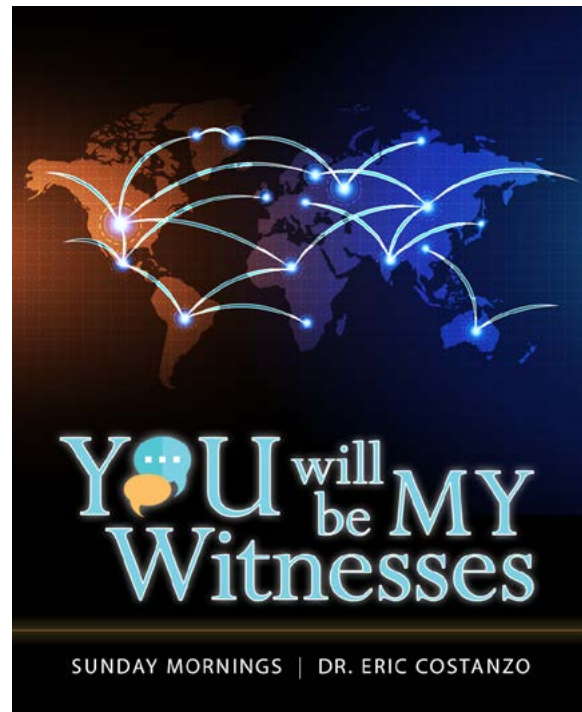
FOOD DRIVE - The Student Ministry is leading a fall food drive for the

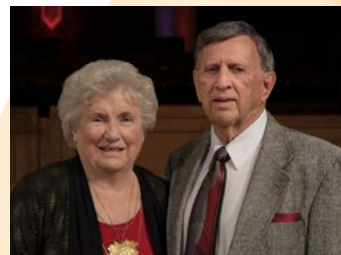
