

Good News for the Middle East

One week ago, two of us returned from a week-long trip to the Middle East - specifically to the country of Jordan - which has become a safe-haven for nearly two million refugees from Iraq, Syria, and other nations in the last decade.

Throughout this past year, God has been opening doors for us to encounter, befriend, and serve Mid-

dle Eastern peoples right here in South Tulsa. These are families with loving parents who also want the best for their children. They dream of returning home someday, when it is safe to do so. For now, they do their best to succeed in Tulsa. Thankfully, they have found in our church a place of welcome and kindness, education, and tangible help. Most importantly, they continually hear about the love and message of Jesus.

We had several purposes for our trip to Jordan:

- 1. To meet displaced families personally in their "homes" and hear their stories.
- 2. To see how the existing churches in the Middle East have welcomed and are serving refugee families.
- 3. To get high-level field training from our wonderful new partner World Relief, who has been integral in helping us establish our international and refugee ministry here at South Tulsa.
- 4. To meet with our own IMB personnel and learn about their work and volunteer opportunities in the Middle East.

5. To take advantage of any other opportunities God had for us.

The insights we gained in a short amount of time were invaluable. The stories we heard were heartbreaking to say the least. Many of them we would not retell. Yet we left without a doubt that God has significant plans for our church and Middle Eastern peoples, and He is equipping us to be more effective in the future.




