What is CARE 101?

One of our newest ministries is the CARE101 Chaplain Ministry, designed to share the Good News with businesses in our community. This week we visited with team leaders Linda Fore, Bobby Jones and Cliff Richard to discuss the ministry.

What's the purpose of this new ministry?

The CARE101 Chaplain Ministry offers a free service to local businesses by helping their employees deal with life issues. Because life can often be intense and very stressful, employees run through their daily routine and avoid the very life issues that need to be addressed. We provide trained chaplains for employees to talk to about issues that may directly or indirectly impact their performance on the job. By pro-actively building relationships with individuals the coach/advisor can be a friend with practical life experience with whom employees can really talk to with total confidentiality.

What kind of training have our CARE101 Chaplains gone through?

With the leadership of our Baptist General Convention of Oklahoma and the North American Mission Board, over 20 individuals have completed in-house chaplaincy training that provides resources to share with the employees of businesses we serve.

What businesses have we partnered with for this ministry?

To begin this ministry, we have approached several businesses in our community that our church family has relationships with - retirement homes, businesses that service and interact with our church, and businesses our members may lead.

Why are the Chaplains being commissioned?

The commissioning is the culmination of the extensive training our Chaplains have received through the North American Mission Board. It establishes and gives our Chaplains credibility with the employees of the businesses we serve and with our community.

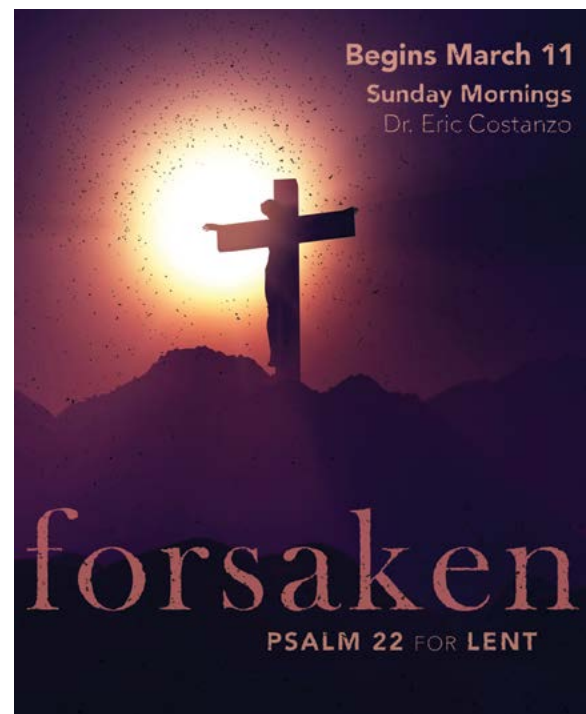
