Meet Eddie Rock

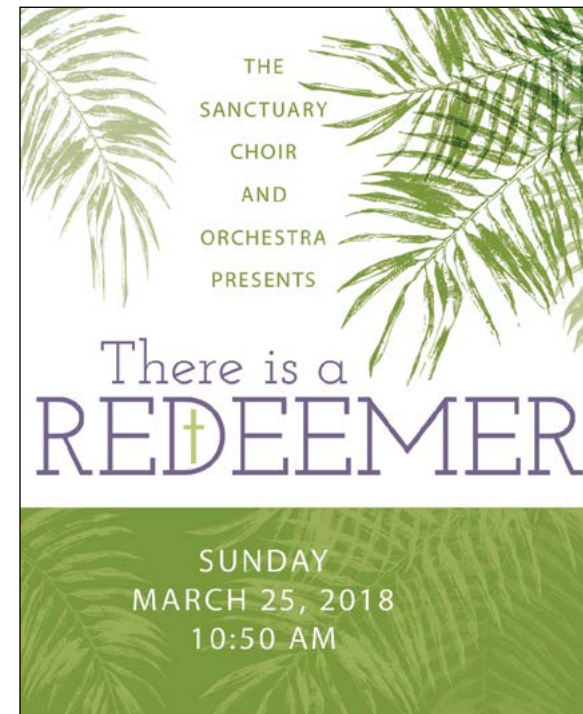
who joined the church on February 4!
