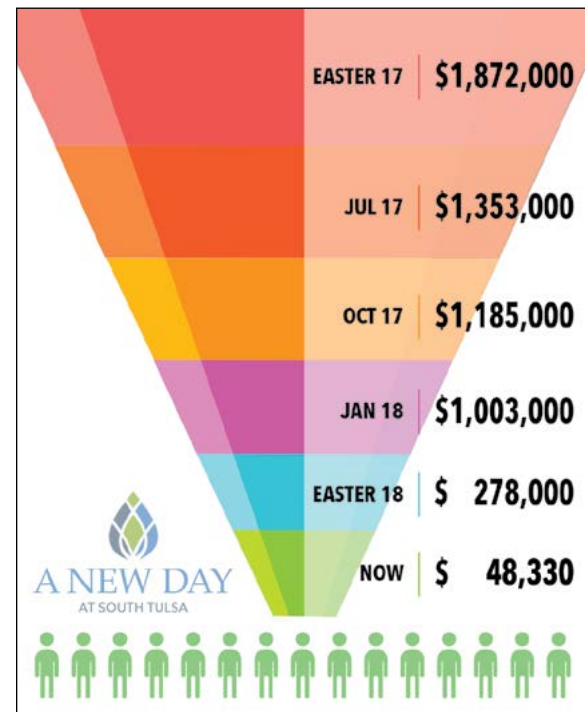

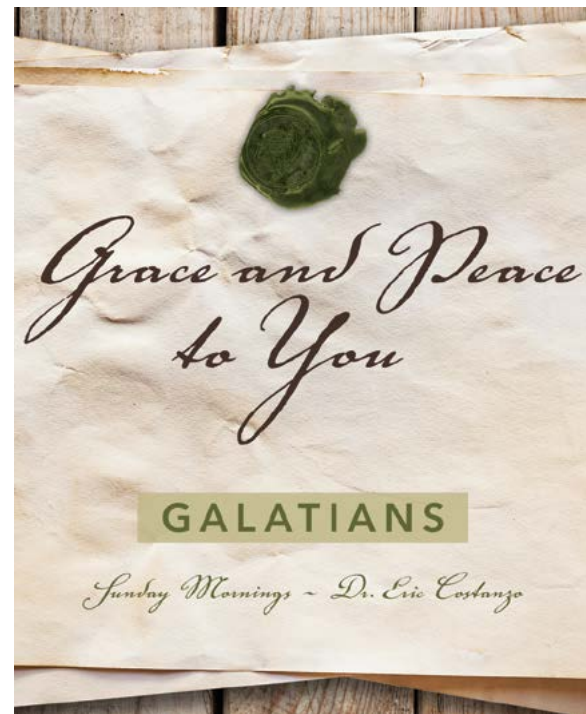
Falls Creek Info

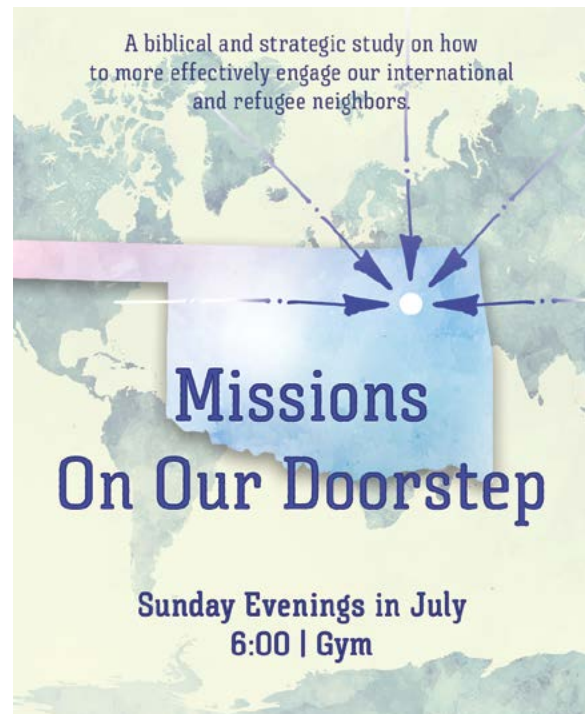
Welcome Sharon Armstrong who joined the church on April 29!

RiSE (Refugee Sewing Enterprise) is a local program that provides sewing lessons, income opportunities, English dialogue, and faith discussions for refugee and immigrant women who live in the Tulsa area. RiSE meets at South Tulsa on Mondays from 10:00 a.m. to noon and from 5:00 to 7:00 p.m. The classes are instructor led, but volunteers are needed to assist with basic sewing skills.
