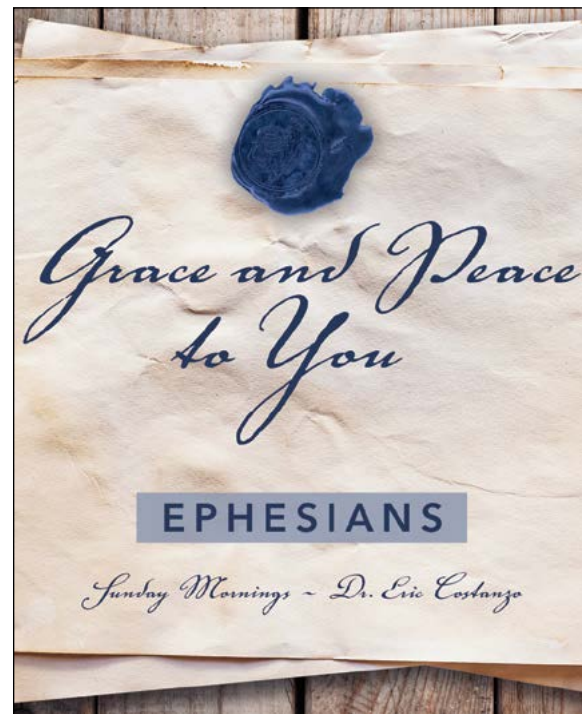

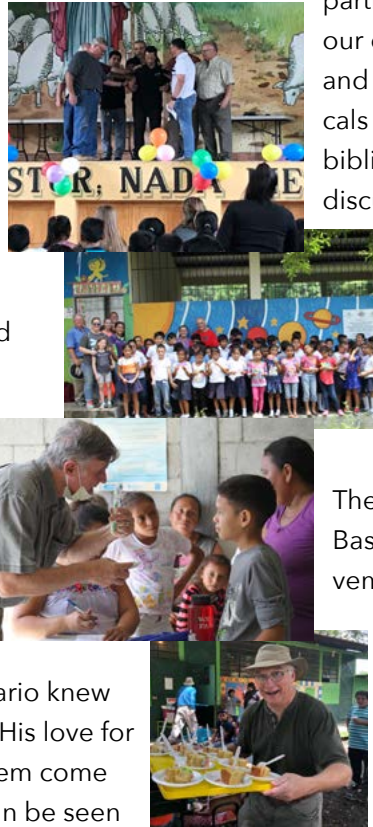
Campos de Sueños in Santa María de Jesus

I feel honored and blessed to have been asked to be a member of the Guatemala mission team this year and to be able to play a small role in what the Lord is doing through our Guatemala partnerships. Today's events showed me why Guatemala, and more specifically Campos de Sueños, has such a hold on the hearts of many people at South Tulsa.

After years of dedication and leadership, Mario Miño was ordained as Pastor in front of a few hundred of the children he invests in on a daily basis. 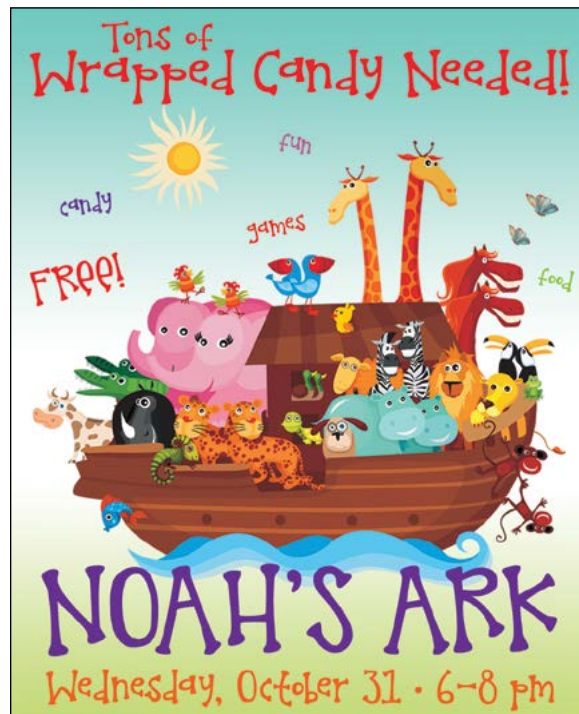
