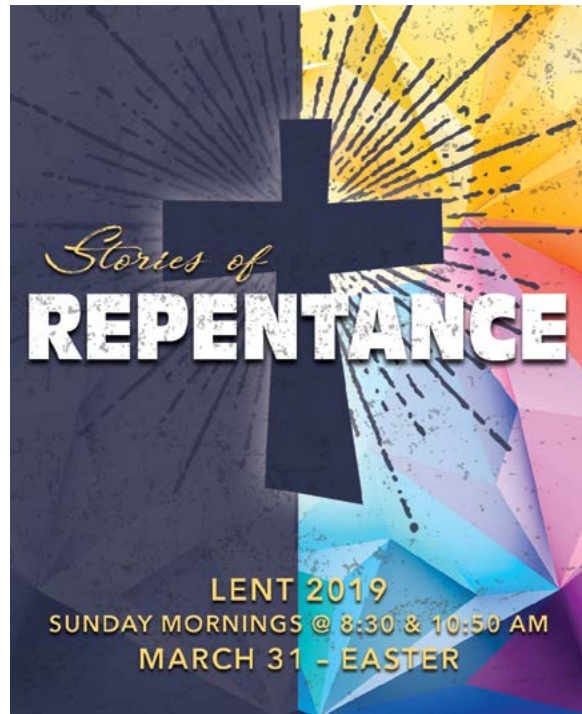

All over the soccer field the groups of students and children sat on blue tarps. We saw 10-15 children in each group respond to the gospel message! It was so powerful and thrilling for us to watch! Our students came to the school in the morning each day, which is different from years past. This gave them the opportunity to establish a relationship with the kids. We believe it really served to break into these kids' lives and establish some trust before we shared our hearts with them.

We were also amazed that the principal of Bella Vista invited us to have a time with all the teachers of her school. On Thursday afternoon, as soon as school was over, Karen Pirtle and Cindy White hosted a conference to minister to the teachers. What a great opportunity to speak life and encouragement into these leaders.

I was overwhelmed at how well our students ministered and worked with the children this year! They reflected Christ's love in such an impactful display that I was constantly moved to tears! Kirwin, a young man who gave his life to Christ as a result of a South Tulsa Belize trip several years ago, brought his students to worship with us on Wednesday night. Kirwin serves as the Student Pastor at Sienne Bight. It was a powerful night of worship and fellowship.

Our recent trip to Central Asia was more fruitful than we could have imagined. We spent most of our time teaching and training pastors, their families, and young Bible students serving among dozens of people groups in three different countries. These men and women are truly hungry for God's word, and their passion for seeing others set free in Jesus' name challenged all four of us on the South Tulsa team.

We also visited established churches and



new church plants in multiple locations, some in places that can only be reached on foot by hiking into the mountains. We worshiped with them, shared Scriptures with them, and brought them love and greetings from our church.

In two different locations, we had the opportunity to share the gospel with people who were hearing about Christ for the first time. Several people came forward to receive Christ or to receive prayer, and the pastors we worked with will take over and connect these individuals and families to churches.

The fields are truly white for the harvest in these places, and the name of Jesus is being proclaimed and believed upon daily in more than 12,500 locations through this one organization alone.

We are praying about how South Tulsa can partner with them, their churches, and church planting efforts in the future. Stay tuned as we share more ways that we can pray for and adopt unreached people groups in the various areas we visited.
