Sunday Bible Study Reopening for Preschoolers & Children

Reservations

- **Sunday Bible Study for Preschoolers:** Please make a reservation for babies-kindergartners by Friday at 5:00 p.m. each week. A reservation should also be made for babies-3's who will attend preschool care during the 8:30 or 10:50 a.m. worship services. Make reservations at southtulsa.org/ps-reservations.
- **Sunday Bible Study for First-Sixth Graders:** Reservations are NOT required. To provide safe and sanitary check-in stations, greeters will provide check-in assistance which may require patience while waiting.

You should NOT come to church if...

- You have a fever of 100° or higher.
- You have any respiratory infections, or have had a cough, sneezing regularly, had shortness of breath, vomiting or diarrhea within the last 24 hours.
- In the previous 14 days, you have been in close contact with someone with a confirmed diagnosis of COVID-19, or someone who is ill and experiencing symptoms of COVID-19.
- In the previous 14 days, you have traveled on a cruise or internationally.

Upon Arrival

- All teachers and children will have their temperature taken upon arrival by a touchless thermometer. Anyone with a temperature of 100° or higher, will not be allowed to stay. If a fever develops during their time in the classroom, the child will be removed and parents will be called for pick-up.

Preschool Drop-off and Pick-up

- Only one parent/guardian will be allowed in preschool hallways for drop-off and pick-up.
- A limited number of people will be allowed into the preschool hallways at one time. Thank you in advance for your patience.
- Teachers will sign-in students at their classroom.

Preschool Procedures

- Hand sanitizer is located at the entrances for everyone's protection.
- No diaper bags/tote bags should be sent with your children. If supplies are needed, please put in a clear Ziploc bag labeled with your child's name and instructions.
- If your child is still using a bottle or sippy cup, have a second Ziploc with your child's name and written instructions for the teacher.

- Teachers and children will be required to wash their hands upon arriving in the classroom. Teachers will prompt children to wash their hands regularly.
- Staff and greeters will wear masks. Teachers will also wear masks when in close contact with others.
- Teachers of infants will wear smocks to provide a clean fabric between the baby and teacher.
- Teachers wear gloves when diapering and following good hand washing hygiene. Changing tables are cleaned and sanitized after each use.
- Classrooms will NOT intermingle.
- Each child will be provided an individual art supply bag.
- There will be NO snacks.
- Staff and greeters will wear masks. Teachers will also wear masks, only removing them if they are distanced while teaching.
- Hand sanitizer is located at the welcome desk and in all classrooms for everyone's protection.
- There will be no shared supplies.
- **Social Distancing** - Rooms will be set up for social distancing. Teacher will help kids to maintain distance as much as possible. If distancing is ever in question, teachers will ask kids to wear their masks.
- If a child finds it difficult to comply with distancing and/or masks wearing when asked by the teacher, the child will be asked to step out of the classroom to discuss its importance with the children's minister. The child can then return to the classroom. If the child should be removed again, the parent will be called for pick-up.
- There will be NO snacks.

Elementary Drop-off and Pick-up

- Parents should walk their children to the new South Tulsa Kids check-in area in the Commons, allow the greeter to check-in their child, then walk them to the secure staircase to go to class. *NOTE: Parents may walk their kids to class if they wish.*
- Students will not be allowed into the classroom without their check-in stickers.
- At pick-up, teachers will bring their classes to the gym choir loft/stage and kids will not be released until a parent comes into the gym to get them.
- Younger kids will not be allowed to be picked up by older siblings.

Elementary Procedures

- We are asking all first-sixth graders to wear masks in the hallways and throughout Sunday Bible study. Teachers may allow them to take off masks if they are distanced and working on a project.

COVID-19 Diagnosis Procedure

- If a teacher or child who has attended class is diagnosed with COVID-19, all parents of kids in attendance that Sunday will be notified and the classroom will be closed for 72 hours for deep cleaning.
- If a second person from the same class has a positive diagnosis, that classroom will be closed for the following two Sundays.
